(ii) Five (05) years experience in the Seaman Branch of Sri Lanka Navy not below the rank of a Master Chief Petty Officer.

The ability of supervising the maintenance and operation of launches and boats and be responsible for the administration of the crews.

Any other higher certificate of competency issued by or recognized by the Director General of Merchant Shipping of Sri Lanka or equivalent certificate issued by the Maritime Administration of India or Australia.

**Experience :**

One (01) year sea going experience as an Officer in charge of navigational watch

**(b) Remuneration :**

Salary Category : 6:1 (SG1)

Basic Salary : Rs. 48,150/-

Annual Increment : Rs.1,035/-
