BASIC QUALIFICATIONS

- Citizenship : Should be a female citizen of Sri Lanka
- Marital Status : Unmarried
- Age : Not less than 18 years and not more than 22 years as at 31st December 2024
- Height : Not less than 5'3" (162 cm)
- Weight : Not less than 45 kg (99 lbs)
- Eyesight : Both eyes 6/6 (without Spectacles and Lenses)
- Body Mass Index : Between 18.5 Kg/m² - 25 kg/m²

EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS

- Should have passed the GCE (A/L) Examination with three (03) Simple Passes and obtained 30% marks for the Common General Test, in one (01) sitting and not more than three (03) attempts

AND

- Should have passed eight (08) subjects (Including science) with five (5) Credit (C) Passes in one sitting and not more than two attempts and obtained Credit Passes for English Language, Mathematics and Sinhala/Tamil Language in not more than three attempts at the GCE (O/L) examination or the candidates who have obtained a Simple Pass for English at the GCE (O/L) will be considered if they have obtained a Credit Pass for English subject at the GCE (A/L) examination or possess any diploma/degree in English medium NVQ Level -4 or above offered by a university/institute recognized by University Grant Commission. (NVQ certificate should be submitted)

OR

- An equivalent result obtained at an internationally recognized examination (Pearson Edexcel, GCSE, GCE, and Cambridge or any other) as recognized by the Department of Examinations, Sri Lanka as equivalents to the GCE (O/L) and the GCE (A/L) examinations in Sri Lanka (Including compulsory subjects above)

OTHER QUALIFICATIONS

- Sports, leadership and any other achievement in international and national level and proficiency in other languages (other than Sinhala & English) are considered as added qualification

PAY, ALLOWANCES & OTHER BENEFITS

- Monthly pay of Lady Officer Cadet (Including Meal and other allowances) Rs. 91,551.80
- Lady Officer Cadets will be entitled to fringe benefits, covering expenses for transport, uniforms, medical and accommodation
- Those who successfully complete the Lady Officer Cadet Course will be commissioned in the rank of Second Lieutenant
- They will also receive opportunities of serving in UN Peacekeeping Missions, training at foreign military academies and to follow advanced Foreign Courses
