It is hereby notified that the G.C.E. (A/L) Examination is scheduled to be held from 25th November to 20th December 2024.

Admission cards and time tables of school candidates of this examination have been already posted to the principals of respective schools and to the addresses of private candidates as provided in their applications. Principals are hereby notified that the admission cards should be handed over to relevant candidates immediately without delay.

Facilities to download admission cards from 2024.11.18 onwards by accessing official website of Department of Examinations www.doenets.lk have been provided for private candidates who have not yet received admission cards by post.

Any private applicant who has not received or could not download admission card yet should visit the Department of Examinations with a photocopy of the application, a photocopy of the receipt for payment of examination fee or a certified letter obtained from the Postmaster confirming the payments of examination fee.

Any changes to be made in the subject, medium or name cited in the admission cards received by Principals and private candidates,

- > Should be revised online in this time as well by accessing the website http://onlineexams.gov.lk/ <u>eic</u>
- Only one attempt of revision will be given to each candidate.
- > Revision of name, National Identity Card number in the database will be permitted only to the subject of a formal inquiry and failure to authenticate such revision will be caused to reject request in that regard.
- Examination centers in this examination will not be changed.
- The duration offered for changes will be concluded at 12.00 midnight on 18.11.2024.

The National Identity Card issued by the Department for Registration of Persons, a valid Passport or a valid Driving License will be accepted as a valid document to prove identity of a candidate at this examination.

- 01. Appearing of any other person for a candidate at the examination, keeping notes in possession while answering, getting assistance from or assisting another candidate fraudulently, or misbehaving in and around the examination hall shall be a punishable offence under the Examinations Act.
- 02. Using calculators and correcting fluid in this examination is not permitted. However, using non programmable normal calculators are permitted for subjects named Accounting, Engineering Technology, Bio System Technology, Science for Technology.
- 03. Sitting for this examination as a private candidate while studying in a government school shall be a punishable offence.
- Bringing Mobile Phones, Smart Watches or Electronic Devices into the examination hall, keeping in possession and using such devices is strictly prohibited. Any candidate who violates these conditions will be debarred from examinations for five years and relevant equipment may be confiscated.
- In order to be affirmed that the candidates are not using Bluetooth or any other electronic communication device, that all candidates should keep their faces and ears opened as to clearly visible during the examination. Action will be taken according to the law against the candidates who are not following these instructions.
