

Join as an Officer (Degree Intake) to the Regular Force of Sri Lanka Army

BASIC QUALIFICATIONS

· Citizenship : Male citizen of Sri Lanka.

Age : Should not be less than 18 years and not more

than 24 years as at 30* June 2024.

Height : Not less than 5'6" (167.5cm).
Weight : Not less than 52 kg (118 lbs).

· Chest : Not less than 32".

- Visual Acuity : 6/6 (without Spectacle and Lenses).

Body Mass Index: Between 18.5 Kg/m² - 25 kg/m².

- Marital Status : Unmarried.

EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS

 Should have passed Three (03) subjects at the G.C.E (ALL) Examination and obtain 30% marks for the Common General Test in one (01) sitting and not more than three (03) attempts with "YES" for university admission

AND

- Should have minimum of Eight (08) subjects with Five (05) Credit passes (C) in one sitting not more than two attempts and orecit (C) passes for English. Science, Mathematics and Sinhala / Tamil (Not more than three (03) attempts) at the G.C.E (0/L) Examination or The cancipates who have obtained a simple pass (S) for English at G.C.E (0/L) will be considered if they possess a credit pass (C) for English subject at G.C.E (0/L) examination or possess any NVQ Level - 4 or above Diploma/ Degree in English medium awarded by a UGC recognized University/institute (NVQ Level certificate must be produced).



 An equivalent result obtained at an internationally recognized examination (such as Pearson Edexoel GCSE GCE and Cambridge) may also be considered with the acceptance of the Department of Examination, Sri Lanka as equivalent to GCE (OL), and GCE (AL) oncluding the compulsory subjects.

 Those who completed the above-mentioned qualifications and who have sat for G.C.E. (A/L) in the year 2023 may also apply on the pending results.

OTHER QUALIFICATIONS

 Sports, Leadreship and any other achievement in international and national level and proficiency in other languages (other than Sinhala & English) are considered as added guilfication.

PAY, ALLOWANCES & OTHER BENEFITS

- · Monthly pay of Officer Cadet (including allowances) Rs. 86,551.80
- Officer Cadets will be entitled to fringe benefits, covering expenses for transport, uniforms, medical and accommodation.
- Those who successfully complete the Officer Cadet Course will be commissioned in the rank of Second Lieutenant.
- They will also receive opportunities of serving in UN Peocekeeping Missions, training at foreign military academies and to follow advanced Foreign Courses.
