FACULTY OF FISHERIES AND OCEAN SCIENCES

BSc (General / Hons.) in Fisheries & Marine Science

Students will be selected based on rank of the order calculated using Z-Score and aptitude test. Students who perform exceptionally well in the three-year degree will be selected for the Honours Degree.

Entry Qualifications:

At least three "S" passes obtained from one sitting from the G.C.E.(A/L) 2024, within maximum of three attempts in Bio Science stream.

BSc (General / Hons.) in Oceanography

Students will be selected based on rank of the order calculated using Z-score and aptitude test mark.

Entry Qualifications:

At least three "S" passes obtained from one sitting from the G.C.E. (A/L) 2024, within maximum of three attempts in Physical Science / Bio Science streams (should include Physics or Mathematics as a subjects.)

B Tech (General / Hons.) in Aquaculture and Seafood Technology

Students will be selected for the General degree in Aquaculture and Seafood Technology through an aptitude test. Students who perform exceptionally well in the three year degree will be selected for the Honours Degree.

Entry Qualifications:

NVQ level 5 or above in the relevant technology areas (Aquaculture, Food Technology), or at least three "S" passes obtained from one sitting from the G.C.E. (A/L) 2024, within maximum of three attempts in Bio-System Technology / Bio Science stream.

BSc (Hons.) in Marine Biotechnology

Students will be selected for the degree in Marine Biotechnology through an aptitude test.

Entry Qualifications:

At least Three "S" passes obtained from one sitting from the G.C.E. A/L (2024), within maximum of three attempts in Bio science stream / Biosystem Technology stream.

BSc (Hons.) in Marine Engineering

Students will be selected based on rank of the order calculated using Z-score and marks obtained from the aptitude test. All enrolled students must forward a government-approved medical test report after being selected for registration to the university as a mandatory entry requirement.

Entry Qualifications:

At least two "C" and one "S" passes (including Combined Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry) obtained from one sitting from the G.C.E. (A/L) 2024, within maximum of three attempts in Physical Science stream.

BSc (General / Hons.) in Maritime Transportation Management and Logistics

Students will be selected for the degree in Maritime Transportation Management and Logistics through an aptitude test. Students who perform exceptionally well in the three year degree will be selected for the Honours Degree.

Entry Qualifications:

At least three "S" passes obtained from one sitting from the G.C.E. (A/L) 2024, within maximum of three attempts in any stream.

BSc (General / Hons.) in Coastal and Marine Resources Management

Students will be selected through an aptitude test for the three-year general degree in Coastal and Marine Resources Management. Those who perform exceptionally well in the three-year General degree will be selected for the Honours Degree.

Entry Qualifications:

At least three "S" passes obtained from one sitting from the G.C.E. (A/L) 2024, within maximum of three attempts in any stream.

BSc (Hons.) in Maritime Affairs

Students will be selected for the degree in Maritime Affairs through an aptitude test.

Entry Qualifications:

At least Three "S" passes obtained from one sitting from the G.C.E. A/L (2024), within maximum of three attempts in any stream.
