INTERNAL AUDITOR

Job Objective:

Reporting to the Commission's Audit Committee, the Head of Internal Audit ensures the Commission's internal control systems are adequate, effective, and compliant with regulations and provides objective assurance that internal controls, governance and accounting processes are operating effectively.

Overall Responsibilities :

- Develop the annual risk-based audit plan and present it to the Commission's Audit Committee.
- Implement and monitor internal audit policies, procedures and guidelines and report to the Commission's Audit Committee.
- Develop and continuously evaluate internal controls for improvement in policies and processes.
- Review of the reliability and integrity of financial and operating information.
- Review of systems established to ensure compliance with policies, procedures, laws and regulations.
- Review means of safeguarding the assets of the SEC.
- Appraisal of economy, efficiency and effectiveness of each division, functions, activities and projects.
- Assessing the different risks of the SEC and reviewing the process of risk management.
- Prepare & present comprehensive audit reports on a periodic basis and follow up on audit recommendations.
- Seamless internal audit stakeholder relationship management.

Skills and Competencies :

- Strong analytical, written/verbal communication, presentation and interpersonal skills.
- Skills in auditing techniques, accounting and management principles.
- Prior experience in organizing, planning, managing, and supervising the audit functions and preparing audit reports.
- Computer literate.

Required Qualifications :

- Member of a recognized professional Accounting/Auditing Body or Bachelor's degree from a recognized University in Finance, Accountancy or Management.
- A class and a Master's Degree qualification will be an added advantage.
- Proven record of 8 years of assistant managerial or executive experience in the relevant field.

Additional Requirements :

- Prior exposure to the capital market or regulatory environment will be deemed a distinct and significant advantage.
- Demonstrates analytical and decision-making capabilities, excellent communication skills in English, Sinhala and/or Tamil, and proficiency in IT applications.
- Strong negotiation skills will be a distinct advantage.
- Age : between 30 and 45 years.

BOARD SECRETARY

Job Objective :

The Board Secretary will support the effective and lawful functioning of the Board by managing Board and committee processes, preparing agendas and papers, recording accurate minutes, and advising on governance, procedure, and conflicts of interest. Acts as an independent link between the Board and management, safeguards confidentiality, and maintains official Board records in line with the SEC's statutory mandate.

Required Qualifications :

- Possess a Bachelor's degree from a recognized University in Finance/Accountancy, Corporate Governance, Management, Business Administration or any other relevant sector-specific qualification; or
- Be an Attorney-at-Law, preferably with a Bachelor's degree in Law; or
- Hold a professional qualification from a recognized Accounting Body.

Additional Requirements :

- A Bachelor's Degree with a class, or a Master's Degree will be considered a definite advantage.
- A proven track record with relevant experience.
- Proven experience in coordinating Board and Board Committee meetings, including preparation of agendas, board papers, and minutes.
- High level of integrity, professionalism, and confidentiality in handling sensitive information.
- Age : between 25 and 45 years.
